## 第三十一屆周年大會會議紀錄

天主教修會學校聯會於二零零七年十月二十六日假九龍窩打老道青年會國際賓館水晶殿舉行第三十一屆會員周年大會，約一百一十位會員學校的校監、校長出席，大會司儀為余立勳校長。

(一) 會議於上午九時十分由劉燕棠修女帶領祈禱後開始。

(二) 大會將英文版第 8 及 11 頁「35 周年」手文之誤更正為「30 周年」後，接納並通過第三十屆周年大會會議紀錄。

(三) 主席報告

1. 主席鍾妙嫦修女歡迎學校的新任校監及校長，邀請他（她）們自我介紹。主席繼而宣讀執行委員會、兩個工作小組委員名單及報告過去一年的會務及各項活動。
2. 主席感謝各委員、顧問在過去一年的付出，又感謝天主教教育事務主教代表胡路明女士及其助理對本會的支持，亦感謝借出場地的神長、校長。主席期盼各修會團體、其轄下學校與及教區學校，能同心同德繼續在聖神的指引下努力，使天國早日臨現。
3. 大會接納並通過主席報告。

(四) 本會義務司庫譚兆炳校長向大會提交 2006-2007 年度經陳潔璋顧問核實的財務報告。報告獲大會一致通過和接納。

(五) 主席提出因香港天主教教育委員會會址已由跑馬地搬遷至堅道，會規 19 項提及的舊地址須刪除成為「本會正式會址為：香港天主教教育委員會轉」。大會一致通過此會規之修訂。



- (八) 胡路明女士致辭時表示每年九月底有教育主日，十月下旬亦有傳教節主日，公教學校於教育及傳教的使命上都有重要的角色。我們應踐行第二篇讀經致弟茂德書提到的「將天主的恩賜再次燃起來 Rekindle the gift of God that is within you」。胡路明女士介紹了天主教教育委員會屬辦學團體層面的架構，10 男 15 女的修會辦學團體共 25 個，分別有 4 男 5 女修會會長代表出席，連同香港教區主教、輔理主教、副主教、總務長、教區數十學校與明愛六十多教育服務機構的負責代表等，共議教育事務；另一天主教教育發展委員會為前線教育同工層面的組織，有校長教師等代表，大家像一大家庭同為教育與傳教出力。

回顧數十年來的轉變，天主教學校內教友學生人數由 60 年代精英教育時的 30%，銳減至 80 年代免費教育時的 10%，至 2000 年更跌至 6%。配合時代變遷，要強調將宗教教育傳遞給青年人，須大力重組課程：70/80 年代的聖經課堂，已轉變為 80/90 年代的價值教育、生命教育等非單教理灌輸式的課程。2000 的教區會議表達須重整中央宗教課程，陳乃國博士亦曾為修會學校介紹了有關的「宗教及道德教育課程發展中心」。修會學校須繼續各自獨特的教育神恩，尤其在神職聖召日降之時，更須透過培訓教友保守神恩，將之發揚光大，「將天主的恩賜再次燃起來 Rekindle the gift of God that is within you」。

- (二) 中小幼校監校長靈修日：於 2008.3.7 假赤柱瑪利諾神父會院舉行，主題是「四旬期信仰反省」，神師為關傑棠神父，參加人數 42 人。
- (三) 小學及學前組朝聖活動：於 2008.4.12 到澳門五所聖堂作朝聖祈禱及導賞，參加人數為 32 人。
- (四) 小六公教同學日：於 2008.5.24 在嘉諾撒聖瑪利書院禮堂舉行，主題是「和祂一起跑」，神師為葉寶林神父，參加人數為 680 名師生，參與者獲贈掛繩螢彩原子筆作紀念品。
- (五) 中學教師靈修日：於 2008.6.13 二零零八年六月十三日在聖保祿學校小學部舉行，主題是「與主相遇」，神師為關傑棠神父，參加人數約 250 人。



## 培訓及交流：

### (一) 研討會

1. 為學前組校長及老師 — 於 2008.3.26 至 2008.3.28 寶血會嘉靈學校舉行聯校教師培訓工作坊，來自台灣及珠海的導師，教授有關藝術、舞蹈、體能、音樂及科學的課程，有來自 13 間幼稚園共 287 位老師參加。
2. 為中學組老師 — 本會與教區學校聯會中學組於 2007.12.10 德望學校中學部合辦專題講座。上午主題有關教授英國文學，參加老師 30 名；下午主題為推廣閱讀，參加老師 130 名。講者為專程來自新西蘭之奧克蘭大學高級講師 Mr. Wayne Mills，他每年主辦國際週年兒童文學比賽，歷共十多年。
3. 為全體校監、校長及老師 — 於 2008.2.29 新春聯歡晚宴前，假聖保祿學校小學禮堂舉行講座，主題為「創新與變革」，由彼德德魯克管理學院主席、光華控股有限公司總裁李志剛先生主講，參加者約 180 人。
4. 為中學中層教師 — 於 2008.5.2 至 2008.5.3 明愛張奧偉國際賓館，舉行兩日一夜的學校中層行政人員培訓課程，講者包括有黃若嫻修女、趙李婉儀校長、蔡關怡清校長、康文海校長及陳德恆校長。參加人數為 54 人。
5. 為全體校監、校長 — 共約 10 位校長及校監，於 2008 年 4、5 月參與由中聯辦邀請的四川及山東濟南兩次交流活動。
6. 為全體校監、校長 — 於 2008.11.7 周年大會後舉行，主題為「聖保祿與教育」，由方濟會黃國華神父主講。

### (二) 中學生紐西蘭學習團

於 2008.7.19 至 2008.8.4 舉行，此為教區學校聯會（中學組）與修會學校聯會中學組合辦的活動。由於修會學校聯會分配得之名額只有約 30 個，故只開放給中學組委員學校之初中學生報名。今年參加的 31 名同學來自 5 間執委學校。

## 出版及紀念品：

學前教育組刊物「育化」第 22、23 期分別於 2007 年 12 月及 2008 年 6 月出版。而新製一批黑字金邊的本會襟章，則在 2008.11.7 會員大會上首次派發給與會者。

## 其他：

### (一)「聖召徵文比賽」

由培聖會及公教報合辦之「聖召徵文比賽」於二零零八年一月至三月期間於各學校舉行，評選工作由教區學校聯會及本會校長擔任。本會的張偉菁校長、陳潔璋顧問、周周啟華顧問、黃振宗校長、鍾妙嫦修女、蔡關怡清校長、鄔萃芬校長及余富強神父擔任本年度評選裁判，並於 2008.5.31 舉行頒獎禮。

### (二) 對開辦「新高中宗教及倫理科」的意見搜集與跟進工作

因應會員學校對開辦「新高中宗教及倫理科」的關注，中學組曾於 2008.3.17 向會員學校進行問卷調查，在 39 份回覆中有 19 所中學有意以聯校形式開辦此課程。有關校長曾於 2008.6.13 聚首，議定將此等學校按地區及該科教學語言，分為四組，分別由中學組各成員校長，充當臨時聯召集人，聯絡組別內其他校長，研究籌辦聯校課程的可行性與具體細則。





## Minutes of the 31st Annual General Meeting

The 31<sup>st</sup> Annual General Meeting was held at the Crystal Ball Room of YMCA International House, 23 Waterloo Road on 26<sup>th</sup> October 2007. Over 110 Supervisors and Principals of member schools attended. The M.C. was Mr. Peter Yu Lap Fun.

1. The Meeting began at 9:10a.m. Sr. Teresa Lau Yin Tong led the opening prayer.
2. The minutes of the 30<sup>th</sup> Annual General Meeting were adopted after amending errors on P.8 and P. 11 of the English version, with “30<sup>th</sup>” mistaken as “35<sup>th</sup>”.
3. The Chairperson’s Report
  - a. Sr. Lucy Chung, the Chairperson, welcomed and introduced all new Supervisors and new Principals at the meeting. She gave an account of all members in the executive committee and in the two sub-committees and reported on Council affairs and activities held in the previous year.
  - b. She thanked all committee members and advisors for the effort they had made, Ms. Alice Woo, the Episcopal Delegate for Education and her Assistants for their continual support, and priests, sisters and principals who had offered their school facilities for Council activities. She sincerely hoped for the guidance of the Holy Spirit in helping different religious communities, religious schools and diocesan schools to work together whole heartedly for the coming of the Kingdom of God.
  - c. The Chairperson’s Report was adopted.
4. Mr. George Tam, the Honorary Treasurer presented the 2006-2007 financial report that had been verified by Ms. Chan Kit Cheung. The report was unanimously adopted.
5. The Chairperson proposed to amend Council Regulation No.19 by deleting the old address in the said item, which became “The official address of the Executive Committee shall be: c/o Hong Kong Catholic Board of Education” as the latter had moved from Happy Valley to Caine Road. The amendment was unanimously adopted.

Ms. Alice Woo, the Episcopal Delegate for Education, pointed out in her speech that the Catholic Diocese annually celebrates Education Sunday in September and Mission Sunday in October and Catholic schools had important roles to play both in education and evangelization. We should practise what was mentioned in the second reading of St. Paul's second letter to Timothy, "...rekindle the gift of God that is within you..." She explained that the Hong Kong Catholic Board of Education, co-ordinates 25 different schools sponsoring bodies, 10 of which are men's and 15 women's religious institutes. Superiors from 4 men's and 5 women's religious institutes, together with the Bishop of Hong Kong, the Auxiliary Bishop of Hong Kong, the Vica General, the Procurator, as well as representatives from diocesan schools and from over 60 Caritas educational institutes meet and discuss educational affairs. At the same time the Hong Kong Catholic Education Development Committee, consisting of school principals and teachers, co-ordinates frontline educators. These two organizations work together as one family to serve Hong Kong Catholic education.

Looking back at the changes that have taken place in recent few decades, the number of Catholic students in Catholic schools dropped drastically from 30% in the 60's to 10% in the 80's when the Government provided compulsory education, then further to 6% in 2000. In response to the new era we need to restructure the curriculum effectively in order to pass on our faith to our young. The Biblical Studies curriculum in the 70's / 80's gradually evolved into Value Education or Life Education in the 80's / 90's which is no longer simple indoctrination of the catechism. In 2000 the diocese expressed the need to reorganize the curriculum of our religious education. Dr. Francis Chan had introduced to religious schools the Religion and Moral Education Centre. Religious schools had to cherish their unique gifts from God in their educational mission and pass them on through lay people, especially in the days since vocations have been declining.

## **AGM, General & Committee Meetings**

1. 07/08 AGM - The 31<sup>st</sup> Annual General Meeting was held in the morning of 2007.10.26 at YMCA International House, Waterloo Road. After the AGM there was a talk and a lunch buffet.
2. 1<sup>st</sup> General Meeting – 180 School Supervisors, Principals and teachers attended the seminar held on 2008.2.29 at St. Paul’s Convent School (Primary). (refer to Seminars no.3). A dinner gathering at Regal Hong Kong Hotel followed and there were about 70 participants.
3. 2<sup>nd</sup> General Meeting - An Annual Retreat for School Supervisors and Principals was held on 2008.3.7 at the Maryknoll Fathers Regional House, Stanley (refer to Religious Activities no. 2)
4. The Executive Committee, the Secondary & Post-Secondary Sub-Committee and the Pre-School Education & Primary Schools Sub-Committee each met five times during the school year.
5. 08/09 AGM – The 32<sup>nd</sup> AGM is to be held on 2008.11.7 at YMCA International House, Waterloo Road, followed by a talk and a buffet lunch.

## **Religious Activities**

1. Retreat for primary school teachers – Originally two identical events had been scheduled on 2008.3.1 and 2008.3.15 at Maryknoll Convent School ( Primary Section ). Rev. Tsui Kam Yiu, Luke was the Retreat Master. The no. of participants enrolled were 279, 285 respectively and the total was 564. The first event ran smoothly and participants received gifts of DVDs and CD from Rev. Tsui. However the second event was cancelled due to the EDB arrangement of an early onset of Easter holidays in primary schools in response to a threatened epidemic of influenza.
2. The Annual Retreat for all Supervisors and Principals – It was held on 2008.3.7 at the Maryknoll Fathers House. Rev. John Kwan Kit Tong was the Retreat Master. The theme was “Spiritual Reflection of the Season of Lent” and 42 members participated.
3. The Pilgrim Visit for Pre-School Education / Primary Schools – A pilgrim tour to five churches in Macau was held on 2008.4.12. There were 32 participants.
4. The Primary Six Catholic Students Day – This was held on 2008.5.24 at St. Mary’s Canossian College. The theme was “Run With Him” The spiritual master was Rev. Deacon Martin Ip. Altogether 680 pupils and teachers participated.
5. Retreat for secondary school teachers – This was held on 2008.6.13 at St. Paul’s Convent School (Primary). The theme was “Encounter With The Lord” The spiritual master was Rev. John Kwan Kit Tong and about 250 teachers participated.

## **Seminars and Tours**

1. Seminars
  - a) For Pre-School Education / Primary Schools Principals and teachers – A workshop was organized at Ka Ling School of the Precious Blood from 2008.3.26 to 2008.3.28. Mentors from Taiwan and Zhu Hai delivered courses on arts, dance, music, science and physical education. There were 287 participants from 13 kindergartens.

- b) For Secondary school teachers – A seminar was held jointly with the Secondary Section of the Hong Kong Diocesan Schools Council on 2007.12.10 at Good Hope School. 30 teachers participated in the morning session on the Teaching of English Literature. 130 teachers attended the afternoon session on the Promotion of Reading. The speaker was Mr. Wayne Mills, Senior Lecturer of Auckland University New Zealand. He has been organizing the annual international Kids’ Lit. Quiz for ten years.
- c) For all Supervisors, Principals and teachers – A seminar on “Innovation & Change” was organized on 2008.2.29 at St. Paul’s Convent School (Primary) just before the Lunar New Year Dinner. The speaker was Mr. Stephen Lee, President of Bright China Limited, and Chairman of Peter F. Drucker Academy. There were about 180 participants.
- d) For middle managers in secondary schools – A training camp was held from 2008.5.2 to 2008.5.3 at Caritas Oswald Cheung International House, Aberdeen for middle managers in secondary schools. Speakers were Sr. Cecilia Wong, Mrs. Stella Chiu, Mrs. Choi Kwan Yee Ching, Mr. Hong Man Hoi, and Mr. Chan Tak Hang, all being Principals or former Principals. There were 54 participants.
- e) For all Supervisors and Principals – A total of about 10 Principals and School Supervisors joined 2 different study tours in April and May 2008, one to Si Chuan and the other to Shan Dong – Ji Nan. These tours were organized by the Liaison Office of the Central People’s Government in the HKSAR.
- f) For all Supervisors and Principals – A talk on “St. Paul and Education” by Rev. Placid Wong OFM is scheduled after the 08/09 AGM at YMCA International House on 2008.11.7.

## 2. New Zealand Study Tour for students

This was jointly organized with the Diocesan School Council (Secondary Section) from 2008.7.19 to 2008.8.4. As the quota allocated to RSC was about 30, the function was opened only to students of member schools of the Secondary Schools Sub-committee. This year 31 participating students came from 5 different Sub-committee member schools.

## **Publication & Council Badge**

The 22<sup>nd</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup> volumes of “Yu Hua” for pre-school education were published in December 2007 and June 2008 respectively. Newly made Council badges would be distributed to participants of AGM on 2008.11.7 for the first time.

## **Others**

### 1. Essay Competition on Vocation

Kung Kao Po and the International Serra Club organized the competition jointly in January to March 2008 in all Catholic schools. Members of the DSC and RSC served as adjudicators. This year Ms. Cheung Wai Ching, Ms. Chan Kit Cheung, Mrs. Teresa Chow, Mr. Wong Chun Chung, Sr. Lucy Chung, Mrs. Choi Kwan Yee Ching, Ms. Deborah Wu and Rev. Jacob Yu were among the adjudicators.

### 2. Opinion survey and follow-up task on “Ethics/ Religious Education as an elective subject in the New Senior Secondary”

In response to members’ concern about the captioned elective subject, the Secondary School Sub-committee conducted a survey among member schools on 2008.3.17. 19 out of 39



respondent schools showed interest in offering the course on a joint-schools basis. Principals of these schools met on 2008.6.13 and decided on the school clusters and medium of instruction. There would be 4 centres provisionally coordinated by Principals of the Secondary School Sub-committee. The groups would work further on a feasible arrangement of a joint-school E/RE course.
